Tim Horton's is a country-wide chain of coffee & donut shops, with an outlet on every second corner, so be sure to come to the correct location. After the visit to RM, we will drive together to:



This map shows the area where we will be operating for the Meeting of the Clans II. North is up. It's about 120 kilometres or 85 miles from London to SL Barn and about the same to RM Restorations. From the bottom left corner of this map to the Detroit border crossing is about 60km or 35 miles. From London in the upper right corner, to Toronto is about 220 km or 140 miles. That's Lake St Clair in the lower left edge, with just the tip of Lake Huron showing in the upper left corner. The map doesn't quite show the St Clair River Parkway at the extreme left, from SL Barn to Sarnia, where we will drive together on Saturday evening.
