

### Hello Everyone,

I have today finalized our itinerary for Sunday's Road Trip. The highlights of our trip will be Day1; Hamilton, **Tim Hortons** first ever coffee shop in Hamilton on Ottawa Street (it

does have 10 to 12 Parking Spots as my daughter checked out. Kim lives in Hamilton), The **13 Street Winery** followed by a visit at **Niagara on the Lake** for a window shopping trip or actual shopping trip on **Queen Street** of this lovely town :-) (I stayed there there some years back with my wife Linda). Then depending on what arrangements you might have made for the evening and day 2 a nice dinner in one of the local restaurants or even the **Revolving Restaurants Skylon** at the Falls (visible in the left lower photo) with your significant other would be nice. I know some of you will already return home after a visit to Niagara on the Lake most of you will be staying overnight (or return to your near by home and rejoin us for day 2 on Subday).

Day 2 highlights will be the **Château des Charmes**, it has plenty of parking space and is a great spot for a Photo Shoot. We shall meet here in the morning between 09:00 and 10:00 am My plan is to return here later for our lunch, (however it is very flexible, someone might have a better idea). after our Road Trip. Once everyone arrived in the morning we will depart towards **Niagara on the Lake**, then we will continue our drive to **Ford George**. Later we will drive along the **Niagara Parkway** back towards Niagara Falls. The Parkway was started in the early part of the 1900s and completed in 1931. Remember to check the earlier PDF files for Locations and time we plan to meet as well as time we will depart.

Once we meet please see me for the Name Tags I have prepared. I will e-mail you the e Emergency Cell Phone numbers so we can text someone if the need arrises.


Bring your GPS if you have one, otherwise Print out this file and follow directions to the meting points.








### Niagara on the Lake to Fort George for Map


